## A Part of the Action

Extraordinary Ministers of Communion serve the Eucharistic life of the Christian community. They are appointed by the bishop at the request of the pastor to assist in sharing the Eucharistic body & blood of Christ with members of the community for which they are commissioned.

Extraordinary Ministers of Communion help the pastor share the holy gifts of the Lord's table with those who have gathered for the Eucharist. They may also be entrusted to take the sacrament to the sick & absent members of the Church who are at home or in healthcare facilities.

Anyone who is a fully initiated member of the Catholic Church (male or female), is at least 18 years of age and wishes to serve their parish community by committing their time & talents may become an Extraordinary Minister of Communion.

If you would like to be considered for this ministry, please contact the church office for the next training date.

As always, anyone involved in a ministry must participate in the Safe Environment Program, which consists of attending a Protecting God's Children workshop, online database and various background clearances.
